Frequently Asked Questions:

Q: Can I still recycle my unwanted computers at the HHWRC?

A: Yes. During the 2009 season, the HHWRC will accept and recycle your computers, scanners, printers, monitors, software, mouse, keyboards, computer accessories, toner cartridges and cell phones from Summit County residents only.

Q: Why can't I recycle my television at the HHWRC?

A. At this time, due to the decline in the recycling markets for glass and plastics, it is costly for SASWMA's electronic recyclers to collect and properly recycle televisions.
